



GALA OF GRACE

Thank you for considering our letter. We are seeking sponsorship for our 7th Annual Gala of Grace, hosted by North Shore Crisis Services Society ("NSCSS"), set for Friday, April 26, 2024 at the Pipeshop Venue. All proceeds will support women and children fleeing violence in our community.

North Shore Crisis Services Society ("NSCSS") is a registered charity that provides emergency shelter, longer-term housing solutions, essential services, food, and preventative education to women and children impacted by violence on the North Shore. Our emergency shelter, SAGE Transition House, was North Shore's first-ever women's transition house. Since then, with help from our compassionate community, we have worked hard to strengthen and grow each of our service programs that aim to address all the ways that fleeing violence can affect a woman and her family.

Our services impact survivors in 2 ways: directly, for thousands of women and children each year who access wrap-around supports from our Program Coordinators, Women & Child Advocates, Outreach Workers, and PEACE Counsellors; and in the community, when we work alongside other like-minded organizations to ensure the safety of each woman and child we serve.

THE GALA OF GRACE

The Gala of Grace is a charitable event that attracts 300+ key female figures from our vibrant North Shore community.

Year after year, the Gala has helped us reach critical milestones for our clients, especially with developing our supportive housing programs and trauma-informed services. In 2020, after tickets sold out in less than 2 hours, proceeds from the event helped us to finally open Janet's Place, our third and newest Second Stage Housing Program that offers longer-term supportive housing for 2 families at a time (typically for 1 year). Here, families have more time and safe space to access supports and continue to heal after their short-term stay at a transition house (typically for 30 days).

The Gala of Grace has touched all of our programs and pushed the boundaries of possibilities for our clients. Over the years, we welcomed more youth into our annual PEACE Summer Camps and built a new library, quiet outdoor spaces, and children's playrooms at our safe homes.

With our 7th Annual Gala, we hope to continue raising funds to strengthen our essential programs, plan our future with confidence, and support more women and children fleeing violence - in addition to raising community awareness through attendance, media support, and social media engagement. Your generosity will reach our clients in the form of a pathway out of violence. We hope you'll join us in forging a future that's free of abuse for everyone.
